JANUARY

January 25–26: If there's a dilemma on where to vacation this year, check out the **BAY AREA TRAVEL & ADVENTURE SHOW**. Prominent travel speakers, consumer seminars, and interactive family-friendly activities help make destination decisions easier. More than 200 exhibitors represent locations all over the world and attendees can experience a zip line, a rock-climbing wall, Segways, culinary demonstrations, and cultural performances from around the globe; Santa Clara Convention Center, adventureexpo.com.

FEBRUARY

February 14–16: For a new take on the smooth moves of a rock and roll legend, get set for **JAMES BROWN: GET ON THE GOOD FOOT, A CELEBRATION IN DANCE**. Presented by the Music Center and the Apollo Theater, this original dance show with Brown's music and new compositions is staged by six world-renowned choreographers and performed by the Philadelphia Dance Company in a combined effort to interpret Brown's artistry and his international impact on culture; the Music Center's Ahmanson Theatre, Los Angeles, musiccenter.org.

Through February 17: See the treasures of Italian jewelry design house Bulgari at **THE ART OF BULGARI, LA DOLCE VITA & BEYOND 1950–1990**. Approximately 150 of the colorful and weighty pieces are on view, including selections from Elizabeth Taylor's personal collection, sketches, photographs, and archival materials; Fine Arts Museums of San Francisco, De Young Museum, deyoungmuseum.org.
